Dear Families,

In an effort to help you with back-to-school shopping, the third grade teachers have developed a list of general supplies, which all students will need to start the new school year in September. Some of the supplies not included on this list will be provided by the teachers. Other supplies, which are specific to a teacher or classroom, will be requested once school begins.

**LIST OF NEEDED SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR STUDENTS ENTERING
THIRD GRADE**

- 5 2-pocket (**no prongs**) folders (1 green, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 red, and 1 orange)
- 1 box of 24-count Crayola crayons
- 2 dozen #2 pencils (no mechanical or pop-a-point pencils, please)
- an eraser
- 3 colored ink pens (please, no black pens)
- 4 packs of **3"x3" Post-It** brand sticky notes (other brands do not stick well)
- 5 large Elmer's glue sticks (to be replaced as needed during the year)
- a large, fabric zipper pouch to hold supplies
- 1 extra-large or jumbo stretchy book cover
- 6-8 black dry erase markers (Expo brand works best)
- 1 eraser for a dry erase board or a new sock
- scissors
- earbuds

Feel free to purchase any of the above items in bulk to stock up and save. Please put your child's name on all supplies and place in a 1-gallon plastic zipper bag.

Markers and colored pencils are available in the classroom. Pencil sharpeners are also available in the classroom. Trapper Keepers are not necessary at this age, and they do not fit properly in the desks. Please do not purchase them for use in the classroom.

Tissues may also be requested from time to time, especially when the cold and allergy seasons arrive.
